



## Wi-Fi Hotspot Program Application

Roseburg Public Library is providing a limited number of mobile Wi-Fi hotspots through a grant-funded program through about April 30, 2021.

Patrons age 18 and older who have a Roseburg Public Library card in good standing (no lost materials and no outstanding bills) are invited to submit an application for a hotspot by **8 p.m. on Thursday, October 22, 2020**. Library staff will select randomly from all submissions, and the selected patrons will receive an activated hotspot at no cost through about April 30, 2021.

When the program ends, the user may return the hotspot to the library or keep the hotspot and initiate a personal contract with a provider to continue service at the user's cost.

Each cardholder is eligible to receive only one hotspot. Those selected to receive a hotspot must sign a Wi-Fi Hotspot User Agreement.

The library is not responsible for any liability, damages, or expense resulting from use or misuse of the hotspot device, connection of the device to other electronic devices, or data loss resulting from use of the device.

Filtering software is enabled on the hotspot in order to comply with the Children's Internet Protection Act. Filtering software may not block all material the user finds offensive.

The library and through extension the City of Roseburg are not responsible for information accessed using the device or for personal information that is shared over the Internet. Hotspot users are encouraged to follow safe Internet practices. It is prohibited for hotspot users to view, display, or disseminate materials that violate federal, state, or local laws or regulations, including those regarding accessing, viewing, printing, and distributing obscenity or child pornography.

The hotspot includes 25 GB of data per month; data is limited (throttled) when that threshold is reached.
